Peruvian and Bolivian nationals eligible for
Indian eTourist Visa facilities
from 15 August 2015

The Government of India had introduced eTourist Visa scheme on 27 November 2014, which was then made available at nine designated Indian airports for international visitors belonging to 77 nationalities.

Looking at the growing popularity of eTourist Visa amongst international travelers, the Government of India has decided to extend, beginning 15 August 2015, eTourist Visa facility to nationals belonging to 36 more countries, including those from Peru and Bolivia.

Moreover, the number of eTourist Visa-designated airports in India has been further increased by seven, bringing the total number of such airports in India to 16.

International travelers from eligible nationalities, including Peruvians and Bolivians, who are planning to visit India for tourism, recreation, sight-seeing, casual visit to meet friends or relatives, short duration medical treatment or casual business visit, for a period of upto 30 days may apply, pay fees, and receive their eTourist Visa by e-mail, as per their own convenience, by following a simple online procedure from anywhere on the globe. There will be no requirement to visit an Indian Embassy or Consulate for this purpose.

It may please be noted that there is no system of Visa upon arrival in India. Persons wishing to avail of eTourist Visa facilities should apply for the same online at least 4 days in advance of date of travel, and ensure that they have received their eTourist Visa by e-mail in confirmation from Indian authorities, and also carry a printed copy of the same PRIOR to undertaking travel to India.
